DESIGNATED/AUTHORISED COLLECTION OF CHILDREN

To make collection of your child/children easier at the end of the school day we are asking you to nominate a maximum of five people who, if you are unable to collect your child/children from school.

- they must be over the age of 18 years and do not necessarily have to be a family member.
- the class teacher will hold this list and will be able to release your child/ren to a nominated person at the end of the day without the need to telephone the school office.
- Please note: if the nominated person(s) is over fifteen minutes late after the end of the school day, you as a parent you be liable for a supervision charge.

Parents or nominated person(s) are encouraged to come into the playground to collect their children. Please note, only adults over the age of 18 will be allowed to collect children. Siblings will not be able to walk home with Year 6 children.

- We do expect that if you are collecting children from secondary school you collect your child from Samuel
 Allsopp Primary first because of their age.

SCHOOL UNIFORM - We expect every child to wear our school uniform every day



Girls:

White Shirt with school tie

Navy Blue cardigan or jumper with Samuel Allsopp logo

Grey skirt or trousers

Black Shoes (no boots)

Boys:

Navy Blue jumper or cardigan with Samuel Allsopp logo **White** Shirt with school tie

Grey trousers

Black Shoes (no boots or trainers)

IMPORTANT

Please remember to write or sew your child(en)s name into their uniform. This will help to return any lost uniform.

All pupils will need a labelled plastic drink bottle which **you** will need to ensure is washed weekly.

Any caps that are worn during the summer months must be navy blue. Please ensure that all uniform is clearly labelled with your child's name as we cannot take responsibility for lost items.

CLOTHES FOR P.E.

Children will need navy blue joggers and a pale blue T-shirt with Samuel Allsopp logo, a pair of pumps and a P.E. bag. Jewellery should not be worn during P.E. for safety reasons including earrings which need to be taken out for PE—it is NOT possible to tape over them.

BOOK BAGS

All children need a book bag to carry their reading book and homework and to bring letters home. Please check their bags regularly. Please purchase a school book bag and ensure your child brings this to school every day. Rucksacks are not permitted in school due to a lack of space to store them.

BREAKFAST CLUB

A breakfast club is available each morning from 8.00 a.m. at both sites for <u>all</u> year groups Reception to Year 6. Parents need to book in advance, by Friday the week before, and must drop their child(ren) in by 8:25 am at Orchard Site or 8:40 am at Victoria Road. Cost of Breakfast Club payable via ParentPay is £2.00 per child.

SCHOOL DINNERS

Children can stay at school for dinner or they can bring a packed lunch with a drink in a carton. Meals are freshly prepared every day and there is a choice of menu including a vegetarian option and all meat served is halal. The kitchen also use Quorn Mince (vegetarian option) in many of their dishes. The cost of a dinner is £2.50 per day which is payable via ParentPay. It is imperative that you keep you account in credit, falling behind with payments could result in you having to send your child with a packed lunch.

We are cashless school, payment for dinners and trips will be via ParentPay. You will be given login details when your child starts school. Please keep account in credit.
